ECVET and Mobility **from the angle of Training Provision**

ECVET as a tool for “recognized Mobility”

Main dimension > PERMEABILITY

2 Strands

- > actors' openness to mobility
- > mutual trust between training centres.

Criteria (among others)

- > initiatives of some stakeholders to promote mobility ,
- > placement abroad is in development
- > Foreign languages EU citizenship or intercultural modules are integrated in VET
- > cooperation networks exist/ beginning of cooperation networks
- > validation of LO achieved abroad exists or development of mutual recognition process

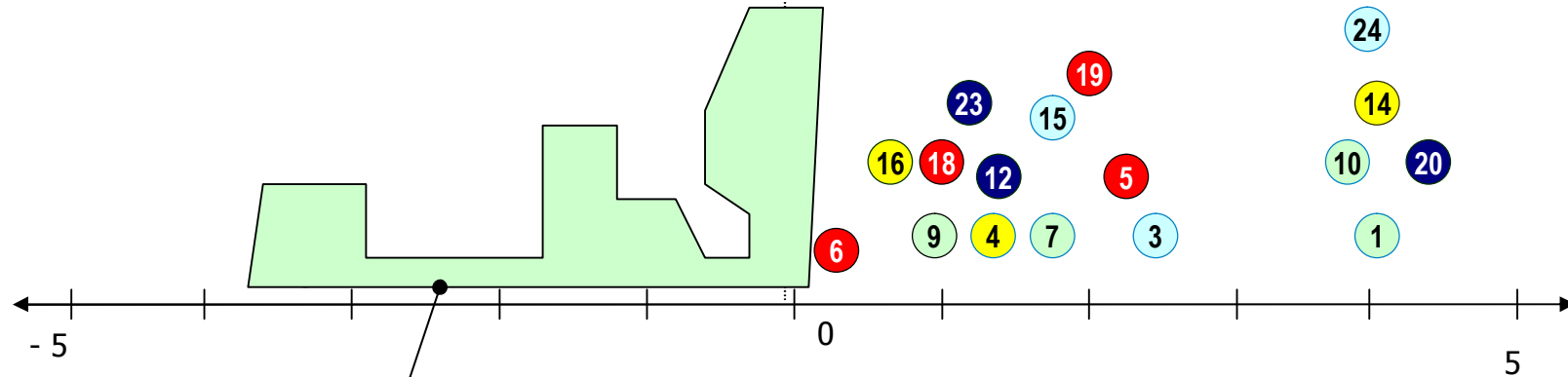

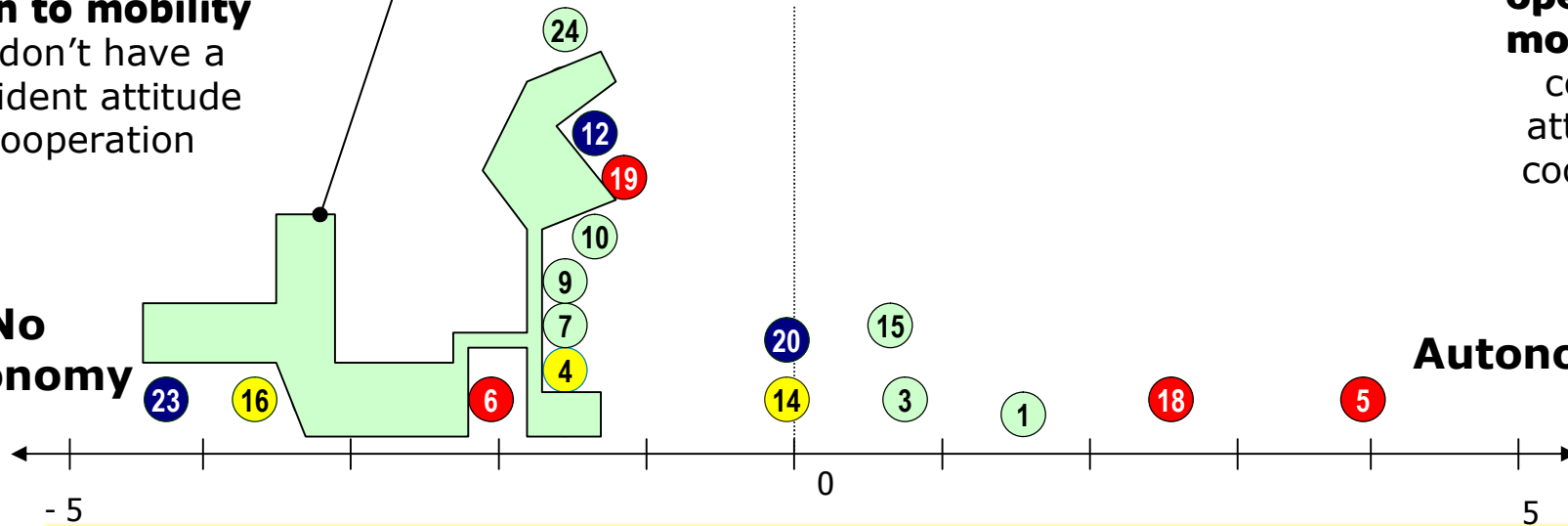


Actors **non very open to mobility** and don't have a confident attitude for cooperation

ECVET and Mobility

PERCEPTION OF ECVET (155 persons / 333 opinions)

A ECVET will contribute to the development of European competitiveness in the 10 next years;	37
B ECVET will guarantee a better transparency of qualifications;	95
C ECVET will develop young person's mobility;	95
D ECVET will improve the comparability of VET systems;	67
E ECVET will decrease the scope of vocational training in each VET systems;	7
F ECVET will decrease the quality of national systems of VET;	16
G ECVET will not respect the actual logic of national VET systems;	17
H ECVET will decrease the attractiveness of national VET systems if they follow European standards;	9

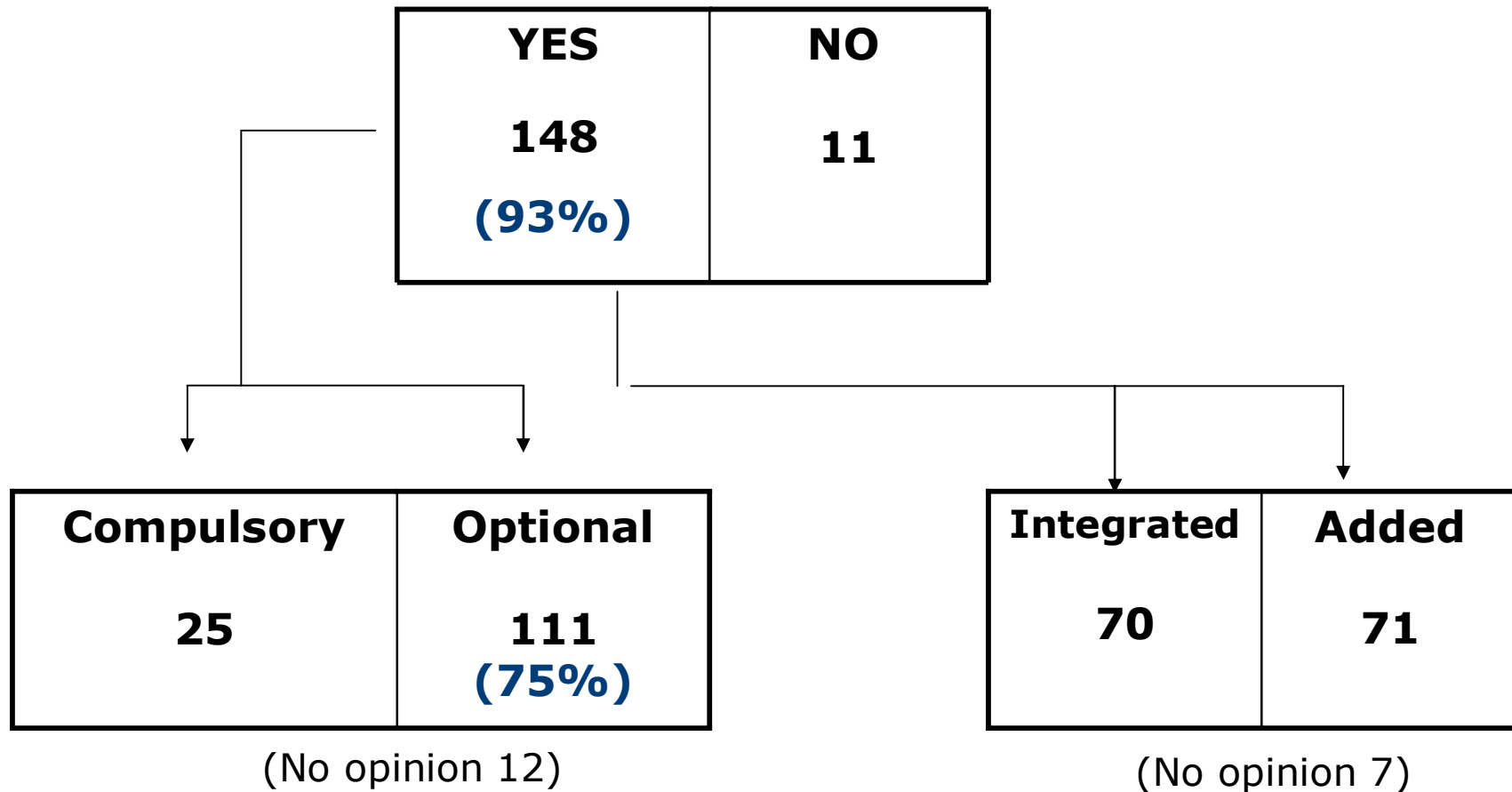
ECVET and Mobility

ECVET and Mobility **from the angle of Training Provision**

- > Learning agreement the key document for Training Providers.
- > Few autonomy doesn't allow training providers to develop mobility as they would like.
- > Generally the European Mobility is a wish, positive attitude and some actions developed.
- > European Mobility expresses the economical or political context (the wish to integrate the European Dimension in training, to participate to European Union perspectives) and creates condition to implement new tools or reforms.



ECVET and Mobility

from the angle of Training Provision

Comments / misunderstandings from experts or interviewees (whatever the system considered)

- > Mobility actions are to be clarified -clearly defined-(in the perspective of recognition).
- > Some training providers using Europass consider ECVET the tool they were expected.
- > ECVET is envisaged as a tool to ease (increase) mobility.
- > The lack of Autonomy of training providers (possibility to sign an agreement in order to recognize L.O. achieved abroad) is often expressed.
- > Mobility easier if module built together.
- > Mobility centred on vocational matters.
