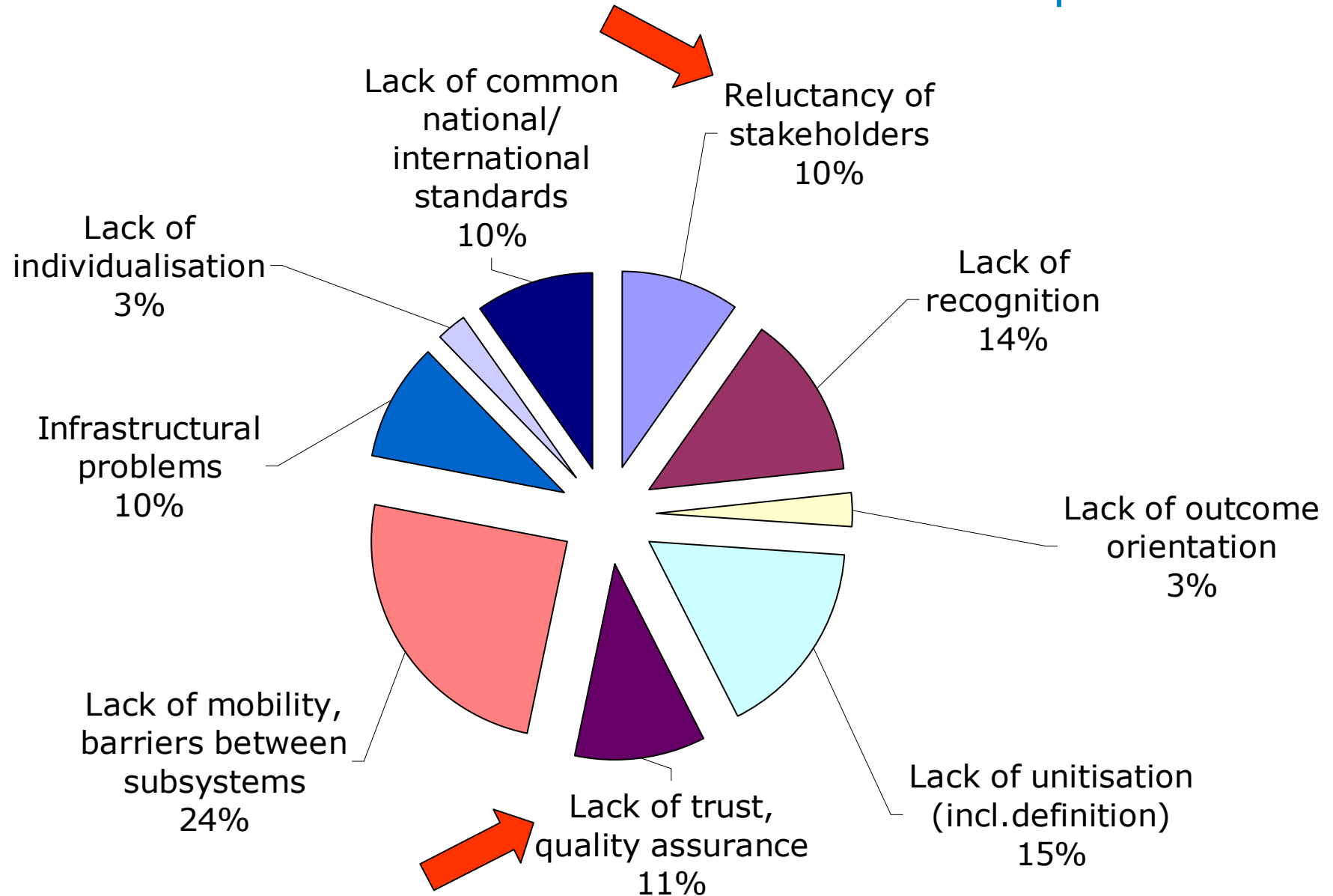




Mutual trust in the ECVET Reflector context

- Trust between stakeholders
 - Different **remits** in the Member States
 - Different intervention rules of the **competent bodies**

 - Understanding the reliability of “foreign” **examination and assessment** processes
 - Understanding the statements out of the **certification processes**

What hinders accumulation towards qualification?



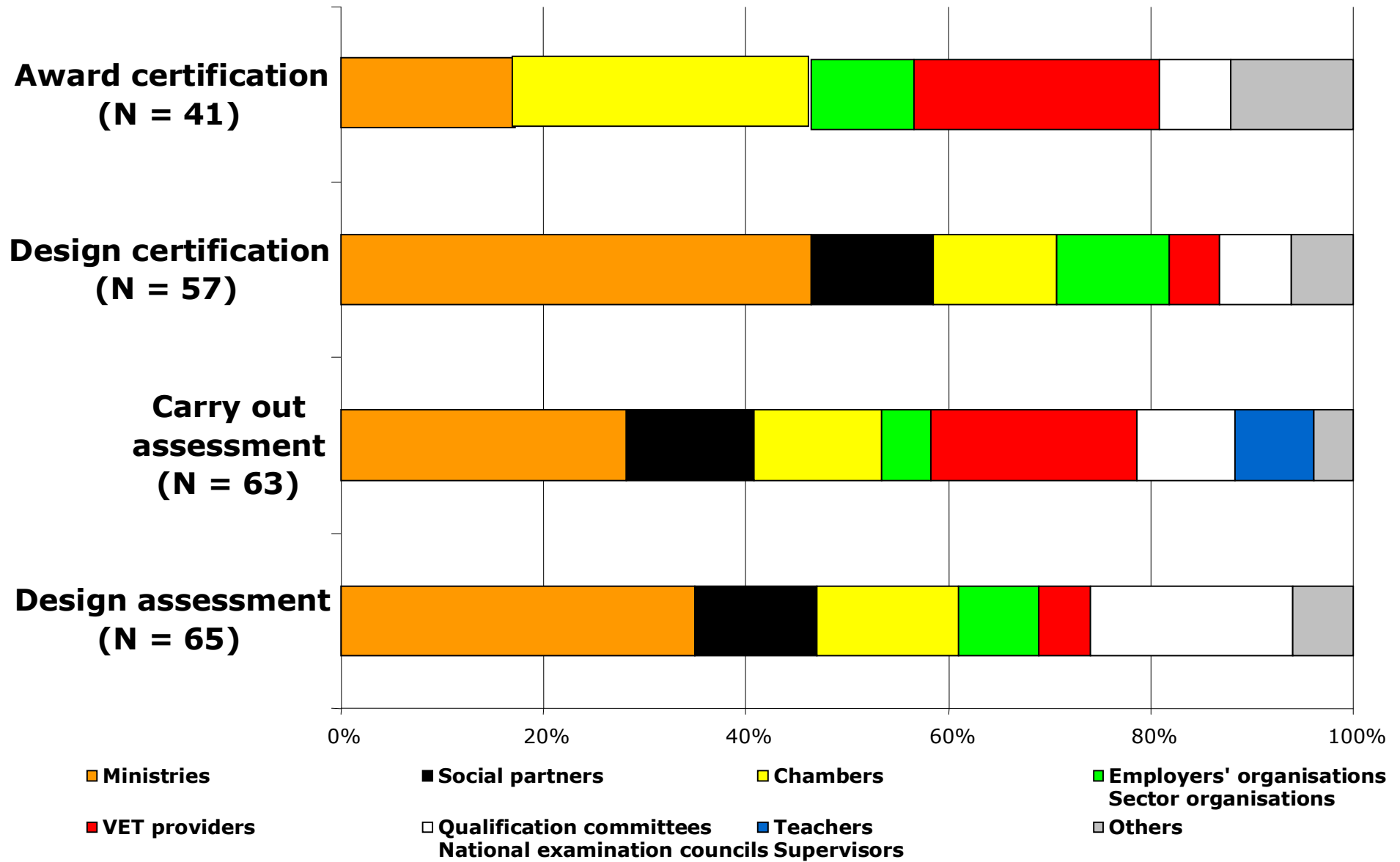

Trust within the national context and trust between national systems

In the context of ECVET implementation, it might be nurtured via:

- No change - specific stakeholders are assigned with new tasks, e.g. national certification authorities;
- Better mutual information; increase co-operation and networking (NARIC-type organisation for VET?);
- Involvement of all relevant stakeholders (incl. social partners and enterprises – change in the scope of their involvement);
- Use of common quality standards (training programmes, qualification standards, methodologies);
- Agreement upon learning outcomes (units/subunits) to secure the quality of the mobility; methodology for equivalence settings;
- ...
