PERCEPTION OF ECVET (155 persons / 333 opinions)

A ECVET will contribute to the development of European competitiveness in the 10 next years.	37
B ECVET will guarantee a better transparency of qualifications.	95
C ECVET will develop young person's mobility.	95
D ECVET will improve the comparability of VET systems.	67
E ECVET will decrease the scope of vocational training in each VET systems.	7
F ECVET will decrease the quality of national systems of VET.	16
G ECVET will not respect the actual logic of national VET systems.	17
H ECVET will decrease the attractiveness of national VET systems if they follow European standards.	9

Main dimension > AUTONOMY

Strand 1 - Impact of certification bodies

- > definition of standards (profile, skills needed)
- > definition of training contents, curricula

Strand 2- level of autonomy of training organisation

- > participation in definition of standards
- > participation in definition of contents or methods
- > participation in definition or realization of assessment
- > possibility for training organisation to develop financial resources
- > fixed resources allocated by regional or national body
- > possibility for training centres to make international agreement

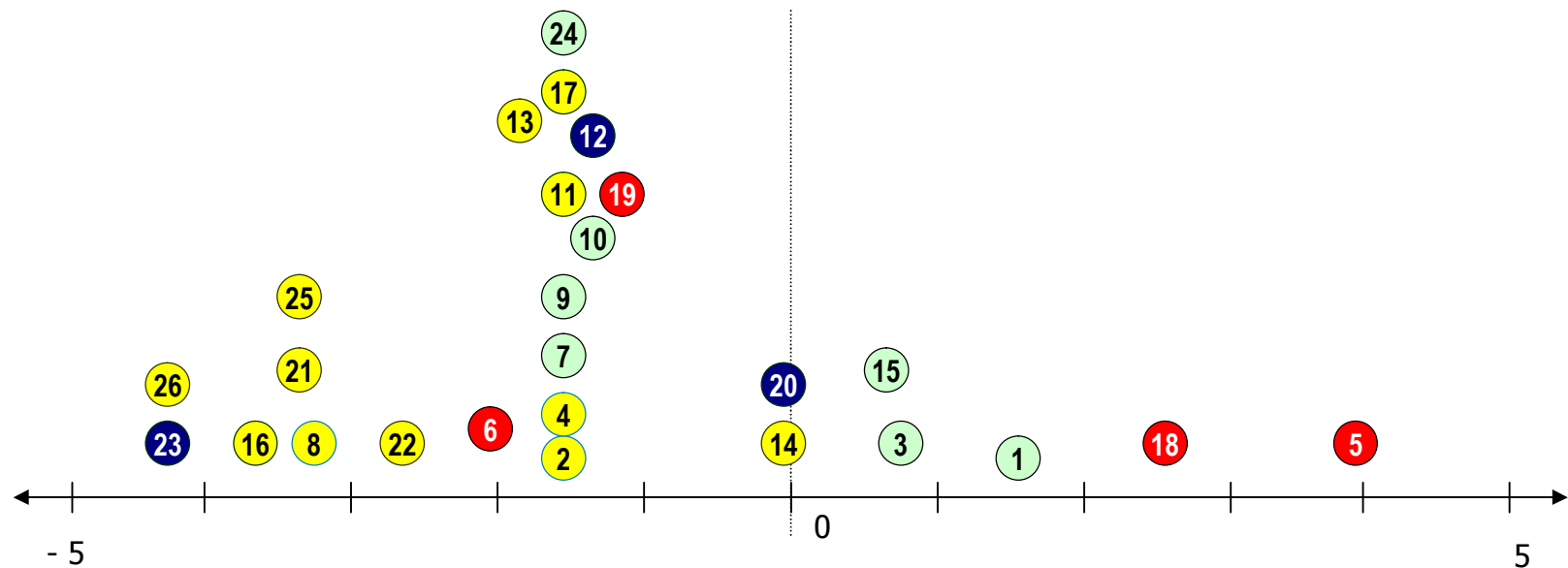

ECVET and Mutual Trust **from the angle of Training Provision**

- > Mutual Trust and impact “recognized” Mobility
- > Top Down way
 - communication between systems
 - construction / development of common training curricula (multilateral way)
- > Bottom up way
 - external and internal dialogue
(training centres* / foreign training centre
training centre / own administration)
 - relevant ongoing or achieved project to be transferred to competent body in order to check appropriateness for validation as “model” or “method”. (multilateral or bilateral)

Centred on knowledge

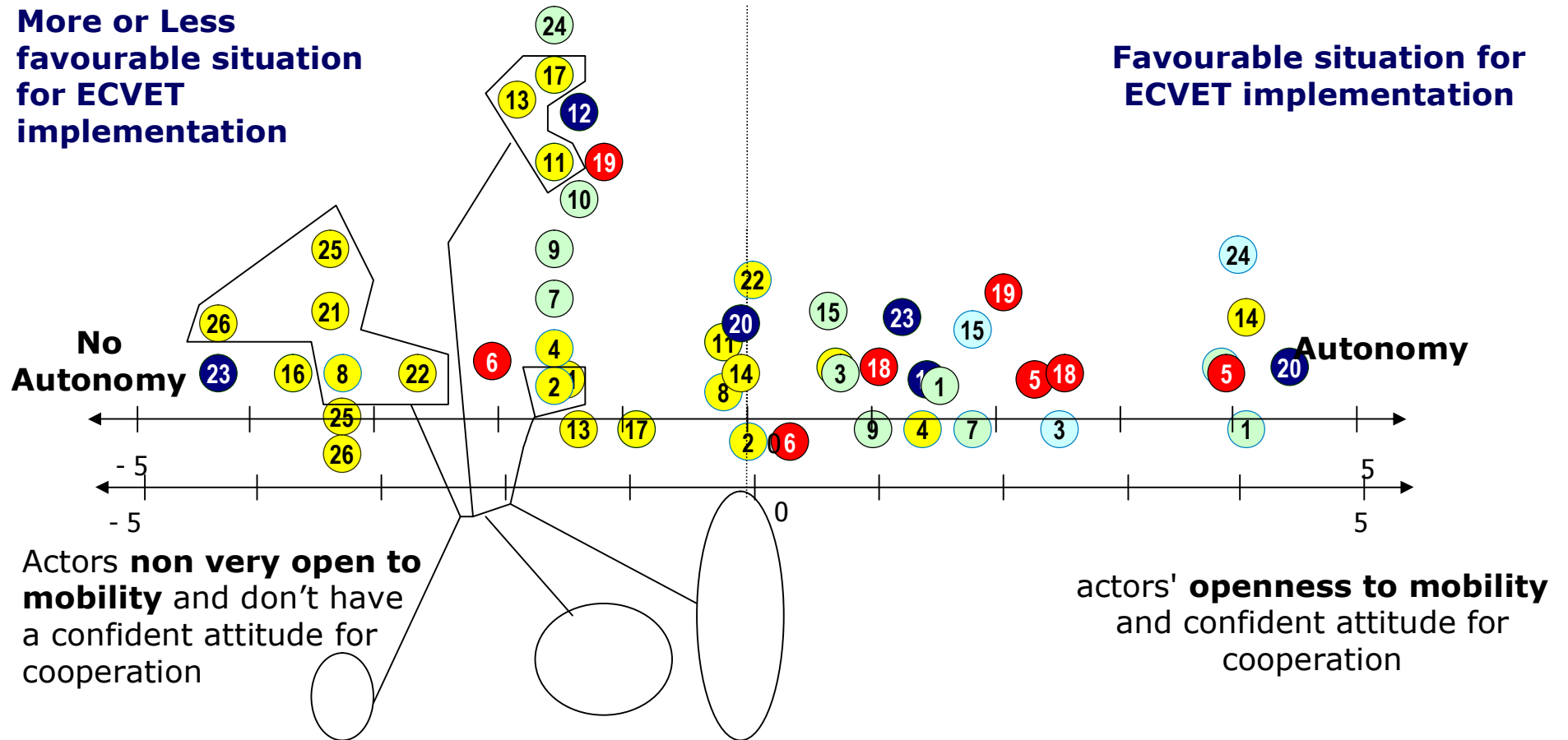
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ECVET and Mutual Trust **from the angle of Training Provision**

- > European openness / Autonomy : reverse tendency
- > Open to European mobility, no possibility to achieve
- > Tools for that purposes
 - Transparency > L.O. and KSC
 - Memorandum > very warm welcome
(it already exists in regular mobility projects as > learning agreements)



ECVET and Mutual Trust **from the angle of Training Provision**

Comments from experts or interviewees (whatever the system considered)

- > Not a uniform interpretation of ECVET, EQF and Europass
- > Different points of view about mobility (Optional / compulsory? Bilateral mobility?)
- > ECVET as a tool to boost the communication “bottom up”
- > Sectoral projects as a favourable approach (common understanding and goals)
